It also showed that less than 50% of Michiganders have a Will or Revocable Living Trust. Without those documents in place at our death, no charitable gift can be made when we receive the best gift, going to heaven. In fact the number is closer to 5% that actually leave an estate gift to their church or favorite charity.
