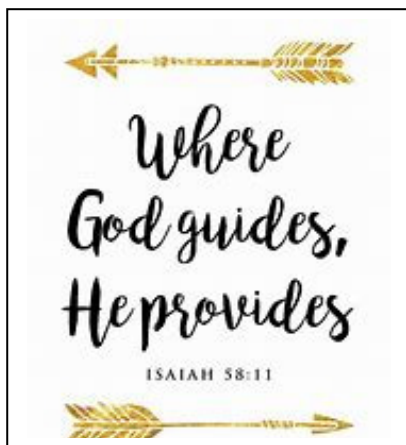


# INSIDE IMMANUEL

## Notes from the Director of Music Our Handbell Equipment

Back in September, 2017 on the Sunday of the church picnic, the needs of the handbell choirs were listed on a bulletin insert; new foam pads, some new tables, and new covers. A handbell fund was set up at that time, and some money has been received. Thank you to those folks who have already provided monetary gifts to help with this cause. Your generosity is appreciated.

The foam pads protect the bells as they are picked up and put down in continuous use. Also, bell-playing technique includes a striking of the bell against the pad, which creates a type of thud sound. This technique helps project certain tones within the musical composition as directed by the composer of the piece. Right now our pads are mushy and need to be replaced immediately.

Our tables are not uniform in size and most of our covers for the pads and tables are very worn.

The total amount of money we need at this time is \$2,500.

On Wednesday, February 21, at the second Meager Meal of the Lenten season, the Handbell Choir of Immanuel will have a fundraiser by serving chili and chicken noodle soup. Your attendance and free-will offering for that meal will be greatly appreciated.

Then on Thursday evening, April 19, all my private students and those under my directorship will give a Spring Fling Concert to benefit the handbells. I will also perform on both organ and piano. A free-will offering will be received. Following the concert all are welcome to a reception in the Great Room.
